Pre-ordering crafts

On the afternoon of the fair, your child's class will be selling crafts that they have designed and made in school. Year groups have produced the following crafts:

Year 3: Calendar and gift tags (pack of 8) - £5.00

Year 4: Christmas spoon and tree decoration - £5.00

Year 5: Reindeer hot chocolate cone and gift tags (pack of 6) - £5.00

Year 6: Christmas cards (pack of 10) - £5.00 Multiple packs can be pre-ordered for this item. A proof of the card will follow by the end of this week.

We understand that not all parents and carers will be able to attend the fair and yet still may wish to purchase the crafts that their child has made. For this reason, we are giving you the opportunity to pre-order crafts. If you wish to pre-order your child's work, please do this via Scopay where you will be able to make the payment. If you have not pre-ordered or purchased your child's craft by 4.30 p.m. on the day of the fair, these items will be put up for general sale.

Year 6 - multiple packs of cards only can be ordered i.e. if you want 20 cards put £10.00 (2 x £5.00) online etc. Make the payment online which we will see at our end and we will then print the cards and these will be sent home to you.

All pre-orders need to be placed by 9.00 a.m. on Friday 29th November. Your child's crafts will be sent home to you by Wednesday 4th December at the latest. If you would prefer to buy your child's crafts on the day of the fair, this is also fine, but we can only accept cash payment at the fair.

Additional stalls

In addition to the stalls run by pupils, we also have visitors holding their own stalls at the fair, selling a range of crafts. It will be a perfect opportunity to grab a unique Christmas gift!

Good Quality Toy and Christmas Jumper Sale

We will be holding a stall at the fair, selling good quality toys and Christmas jumpers that you might wish to purchase as stocking fillers and gifts for your children this Christmas. If you would like to take a look at this stall before collecting your child it will be clearly signposted on the day.

If you have any good quality second hand toys or Christmas jumpers that you would be willing to donate for the stall, then Mrs Hoggan will be collecting these. Please send them in with your child or pass them to a member of staff on the gate in the morning. Thank you in advance for your support.

Christmas Hampers

To help raise funds for the school and to subsidise the Christmas activities we will shortly be making up Christmas Hampers which will be raffled during the Christmas Fair. We would very much appreciate receiving donations of good quality food or toiletry items that can be used to make up the Hampers.
