Dear Parents/Carers of a child in Year 6

VISIT TO OXFORD CASTLE & PRISON – WEDNESDAY 12TH MARCH OR 19TH MARCH 2025

As part of our topic, we have organised a trip to Oxford Castle & Prison on Wednesday 12th March and Wednesday 19th March 2025. We will be taking half of Year 6 on one date and the other half of the year group, on the other date. Please find details of which class is going when, listed below:

Wednesday 12th March 2024 → 6H and children in 6L with surnames beginning A-N

Wednesday 19th March 2024 → 6D and children in 6L with surnames beginning P-Z

Over the course of the day, we will be having a tour of the castle and prison and taking part in a Crime and Punishment workshop. During this, children will explore the theme over a wide period of time and use objects, documents and costumes to find out more about changing attitudes to crime and how criminals have been captured and punished over the years.

In order to cover the cost of this visit we will be seeking payments of £25 per child. ***If insufficient funds are forthcoming the trip will be cancelled.*** Please pay for this online via SCOPAY under the trips and events section. It is also very important that you tick the consent box too or your child will not be able to go on the trip. The deadline for paying for this is Monday 3rd March 2025. If you are having financial difficulties, please contact the school office for advice.

Pupils are required to wear their full school uniform (not P.E. kit) and bring a rucksack on the day of their trip. We will be leaving the school at 9.00 a.m. and will be back in time for the normal end of the day. The children will need to bring a packed lunch (please remember, no glass or fizzy drinks) and ***no products with nuts of any kind.*** **FREE SCHOOL MEALS ONLY** - If your child is entitled to free school meals, we will provide them with a packed lunch from the kitchen if you would like us to do so. Please email adminoffice@manor-junior.hants.sch.uk by Monday 3rd March 2025 to request a packed lunch from school. Otherwise, it will be assumed that you will be providing your own from home.

If your child suffers from travel sickness and requires medication for the return journey then you will need to come in to the school prior to the trip to complete a medical consent form, along with the full packaging of the tablet. Any other medication e.g. inhalers, epipens etc. will be taken from school.
