Next week (Monday 10th February to Friday 14th February) Manor Junior School will be shining a spotlight on music, drama and art as we celebrate creative arts week. The theme of the week is "belonging." Building a greater sense of belonging is a key part of our equality and diversity work at Manor Junior School.
