## **CYCLING / SCOOTING TO SCHOOL GUIDELINES**

Road Safety Team at Hampshire County Council realise that a number of parents / carers would like their children to cycle to school. With this in mind the recommendations should be considered but ultimately cycling to school by children is the parents / carers responsibility.

A permit will be issued when the parent / carer has agreed to the guidelines below:

1. Pupils are advised to attend a Cycle Training Scheme.
2. Pupils are expected to maintain their cycles in good working order. Checks may be carried out at anytime.
3. A cycle helmet (which meets current Safety Regulations) should be worn when cycling and pupils should be encouraged to wear bright conspicuous clothing.
4. All cyclists must dismount when entering school premises.
5. The security of cycles is the responsibility of the individual and measures should be taken to protect against theft.
