Civilisation	A society that has rules, government and can read writing.
Era	A definite period of time in history.
Chronology	A sequence in time order.
Comedy	A humorous story with a happy ending.
Tragedy	A serious story with a sad ending.
Laurel wreath	A round wreath made of connected branches and leaves. Worn on the head, usually as a symbol of victory.
Marathon	Comes from a Greek legend that tells the story of Pheidippides, who ran from the Plains of Marathon all the way to Athens. It is now a long-distance running race, strictly one of 26 miles 385 yards (42.195 km).
