Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our English topic, we have organised a trip to Warner Bros Studio Tour: The Making of Harry Potter in Watford on **Wednesday 4th March 2026**. Our objective for the day is to provide the children with a real-life experience to inspire their writing about the world of Harry Potter. As well as this, we will have the opportunity to experience the filming and studio elements of the Harry Potter films, which will further their understanding of the use of media and film in our computing lessons.

We will be leaving school at 9.00 a.m. travelling with Farnham Coaches and we will be back in school at the later time of 3.45 p.m.

The children will need to wear their school uniform, including a Manor School sweatshirt or cardigan, but can wear trainers instead of school shoes, as this will be more comfortable during the visit.

Your child will need a packed lunch (no glass bottles, or sweets please), ideally kept in a small rucksack. **FREE SCHOOL MEALS ONLY** - If your child is entitled to free school meals, we will provide them with a packed lunch from the kitchen if you would like us to do so. Please email adminoffice@manor-junior.hants.sch.uk by Tuesday 10th February 2026 to request a packed lunch from school. Otherwise, it will be assumed that you will be providing your own from home.

We will have to go through security checks at the beginning of the tour so please make sure your child's bag only contains their lunch and possibly a lightweight coat depending on the weather – although we will not be spending a long period of time outdoors. No other items such as purses/ wallets, books or toys should be brought on the trip. We will not be looking in the shops as they are quite expensive, however items can be purchased online through the Harry Potter website if you would like your child to have a souvenir.

If your child suffers from travel sickness and requires medication for the return journey then you will need to come in to the school prior to the trip to complete a medical consent form along with the medication's complete original packaging. If we hold medicine for your child in school (i.e., an inhaler / EpiPen), this will be taken on the trip.

In order to cover the cost of this visit we will be seeking payments of £30.00 per child. This is being subsidised by the Year 4 Christmas Craft money. **If insufficient funds are forthcoming the trip will be cancelled.** Please give consent and pay for this online via SCOPAY under the trips and events section. The deadline for paying for this is Tuesday 10th February 2026. If you are having financial difficulties, please contact the school office for advice.

We hope the children will have a fun and educational day which will provide a valuable learning experience and a great ending to our topic.
