Would you rather be a Viking or an Anglo Saxon?




Key Vocabulary

Invasion	an <u>incursion</u> by a large number of people or things into a place or sphere of activity
Vikings	any of the Scandinavian seafaring pirates and traders who raided and settled in many parts of north-western Europe in the 8th-11th centuries.
Anglo Saxons	relating to or denoting the Germanic <u>inhabitants</u> of England from their arrival in the 5th century up to the Norman Conquest.
Force	strength or energy as an attribute of physical action or movement.
Motion	the action or process of moving or being moved.
Performance	an act of presenting a play, concert, or other form of entertainment.
E-safety	the safe and responsible use of technology.
