PROPOSED YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP
Monday 19th – Friday 23rd October 2026

At Manor Junior School we try to provide the Year 6 pupils with the chance to experience the social and educational benefits offered by a residential study week.

Residential experience helps develop children's independence and confidence prior to moving to secondary school. The course consists of adventurous and team-building activities such as low ropes courses, climbing, problem-solving, orienteering, circus skills, aeroball etc. Many are surprised by what they can achieve.

We have obtained a booking for an initial 45 spaces through PGL for Osmington Bay for the week of 19th – 23rd October 2026. The total cost of the visit is £415.

The specific costs are as follows:

Tuition, equipment, board and lodging	£369.00
Coach costs	<u>£ 46.00</u>
Total	£415.00

A **DEPOSIT OF £115.00 PER CHILD MUST BE PAID BY TUESDAY 3RD FEBRUARY 2026** in order to secure a place on the trip. You will find the trip on SCOPAY where you must pay the deposit and this will act as your consent for the trip.

Once your child's place has been confirmed, you can then choose one of the following options:

Option 1: Pay the rest of the balance in full (£300), again this will be payable online via SCOPAY

Option 2: Pay in three instalments. The dates for these SCOPAY instalments will be:

Tuesday 14 th April 2026	£100
Tuesday 23 rd June 2026	£100
Tuesday 8 th September 2026	£100

It would be appreciated if you could make a note of these instalment dates in your diary so as to avoid unnecessary administrative time chasing for money.
