### SPORTS DAY 2026

On **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026**, weather permitting, Manor Junior School will be holding its annual Sports Day. The event combines competitive elements with our 'Fun First, Winning Second' style activities.

Whole School Competitive Races will take place between 9 a.m. and 11.45 a.m. with a short break at approximately 10.15 a.m. Pupils will be involved in sprint races, traditional fun races and long-distance events. ALL pupils will be encouraged to participate in a morning race. **Parents are invited to join us for the morning** to watch the competitive events and we will be selling refreshments to keep you sustained! (Cash only please). During the morning races, for safeguarding reasons, children must stay with their house group and will not be allowed to sit with their family members.

At 10.15 a.m. when the pupils have a break, they will be able to join family members who are watching to have a drink and snack with you. Please could you complete the slip at the bottom of this letter to let us know if and who will be joining your child for break. Please do not worry if you are not able to join us that morning, as staff will make sure that all pupils not with someone from home are supervised during this time and have fun.

At 11.45 a.m. the children will come back into the school to rest before lunch. Parents are asked to leave the school site by 12 noon to safeguard pupils who will be starting their lunchbreak at this time. Pupils will then have their lunch as normal before taking part in house team events in the afternoon.

#### KIT

Children are required to wear a plain T-shirt resembling the colour of their house (see below) (**no football shirts will be permitted**) and plain, dark-coloured shorts or, if cooler weather, plain, dark-coloured leggings or jogging bottoms. Trainers must be worn.

Falcons – Blue  
Eagles – Yellow

Hawks – Red  
Harriers – Green

If the weather is hot, please can you provide your child with a cap/sunhat and ensure they are wearing suncream. The children may come to school in their PE/sports wear.

**HEALTH & SAFETY**

To ensure maximum safety of all children we ask that you **do not** bring any vehicles on to the school site. Also, it is important that those of you who have younger children at the Infant School do not attempt to communicate with them.

Adults must also stay in the designated viewing areas. This will enable us to ensure the safety of all children in our care.

A designated toilet will be made available to adults and toddlers. Please follow the instructions of the designated member of staff.

In accordance with County regulations, the school has a non-smoking policy. **Nobody will be allowed to smoke or vape anywhere on site.** Also, no dogs or pets are allowed on site at any time.

**WEATHER**

We will endeavour to run the Sports Day events on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June. If, however, the weather prevents us from achieving this, then we will host the events with the children over the forthcoming weeks. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate parents in these circumstances.
