Dear Year 6 Parents &amp; Carers,

In an attempt to save the number of communications that we send to you, we have tried to combine lots of messages into this one letter which contains some key dates and events. We hope that you find this useful.

**Year 6 Local Walks**

As part of our Geography Topic 'There's No Place Like Home' we will be headed out and about in our local area to look closely at our surroundings. We will be embarking on local walks the week beginning 21<sup>st</sup> September 2026. As we already hold permission for local visits you do not need to provide consent for these walks.

**Day Visit – Southwood Country Park**

On Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> September we are planning on taking the children on another local walk to Southwood Country Park, to complement our topic work. Weather permitting, we will be staying for the day and having a picnic. Please send your child to school with a packed lunch on this day (no glass bottles, please), ideally kept in a small rucksack and ensure they have a waterproof coat in preparation for the Great British weather! We will depart and return during normal school hours.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS ONLY - If your child is entitled to free school meals we will provide them with a packed lunch from the kitchen, if you would like us to do so. **Year 6 SATs Homework**

As you may be aware in Year 6 we are starting to prepare children for the national Standardised Attainment Tests (SATs) which they will be sitting in May 2027.
