<u>Key Vocabulary</u>	
Civilisation	A society that has rules and government and can read writing.
Era	A definite period of time in history.
Chronology	A sequence in time order.
Democracy	Means "rule by the people," where citizens get to vote for leaders to make decisions for their country or community.
Legacy	The long-lasting impact of a person or civilisation from the past.
Marathon	Comes from a Greek legend that tells the story of Pheidippides, who ran from the Plains of Marathon all the way to Athens. It is now a long-distance running race, strictly one of 26 miles 385 yards (42.195 km).
