





Year 4 Home Learning Summer 1

<p><b>In Maths, we need to master all of our times tables!</b></p>  <p>The Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check is in June. The magic number to do well is <u>21 minutes of practice per week on TTRS</u>. That is just <u>3 minutes each day!</u></p> <p>Stick a fact that you are struggling to remember on the fridge. You have to say it every time you open the fridge! (Or you could put it on your bedroom door and say it as you go in and out!) Label it with some ideas: What skills will you need to have to do this job? What subjects in school might be particularly important if you want to do this job? Do you know anyone who does this job?
